## Mission

The Hugh J. Andersen Foundation's mission is to give back to our community through focused efforts that foster inclusivity, promote equality, and lead to increased human independence, self-sufficiency and dignity. To fulfill this mission, the Foundation acts as a grantmaker, innovator, and convener.

## History

The Hugh J. Andersen Foundation was incorporated on March 2, 1962. The original board members were Hugh J. and Jane K. Andersen, and Hugh's sister, Mary Andersen Hulings. They strongly embraced Andersen Family values learned from Fred, Molly, Isabel and Kitty Andersen: giving back to the community, being responsible citizens, and caring for their neighbors. The current board members continue to uphold this commitment, strive to build upon this spirit of philanthropy, and remain strongly supportive of the St. Croix Valley area.

The directors strive to instill in the next generation of Andersen family members the legacies passed on to them by the founders – the value of community and sharing. In 1994, the Next Generation Fund was created as a means for the next generation to learn the various aspects of philanthropy. The Next Generation Fund does not accept unsolicited requests as the members prefer to search out and fund organizations based upon their current geographic and program interest areas.

In 1994, Christine E. Andersen and Sarah J. Andersen each created their own fund within the Foundation to further promote their charitable interests in the community. Contributions from these funds are Foundation grants, not individual gifts. The Christine E. Andersen Fund will accept letters of inquiry if the Fund has provided past support. The Sarah J. Andersen Fund does not solicit nor accept requests.

## Overview

### • Geographic Focus

The Foundation's primary geographic focus area is the St. Croix Valley: Washington County in Minnesota and Pierce, Polk and St. Croix counties in Wisconsin. Programs in St. Paul, Minnesota unduplicated in the St. Croix Valley and utilized by St. Croix Valley residents may also be considered.

From time to time the Foundation may consider programs in other parts of the Twin Cities Metropolitan Area and Greater Minnesota. Please contact the Program Director prior to submitting a proposal to determine if the program might be of interest to the Foundation.

### • Programmatic Focus

Within the primary geographic focus areas, the Foundation is particularly interested in direct service programs:

- Serving children and youth, especially those that provide personal development activities.
- Providing various social support services to the community at large.
- Providing access to health-related services and information.
- Providing educational opportunities and enrichment to the general community.

The Foundation will only consider the following types of programs and organizations if services are provided in the St. Croix Valley - Washington County in Minnesota and Pierce, Polk and St. Croix counties in Wisconsin:

- Special projects or programs in public schools.
- Programs for individuals with developmental or physical disabilities.
- Programs for seniors.
- Public/civic projects and activities.

### In Memoriam: Christine Ellen Andersen

The Hugh J. Andersen Foundation's Board of Directors would like to acknowledge the passing of Christine Ellen Andersen. A director of the Foundation from 1982 to 2010, Christine passed away on April 14, 2011 of natural causes at Boutwells Care Facility in Stillwater, Minnesota. Born September 19, 1945 in Albuquerque, New Mexico, Christine was the eldest daughter of Hugh J. Andersen and Jane Krause Andersen. Christine grew up in Bayport, Minnesota, graduated from Stillwater High School, attended Carleton College in Northfield, Minnesota and Katherine Gibbs Secretarial School in New York City. Christine spent more than thirty years on the east coast, living in New York and New Jersey, where she raised her three children. She was a La Leche League Leader, advocate for social justice and supporter of many organizations both personally and as a director of the Hugh J. Andersen Foundation, as well as a devoted mother and grandmother. Christine is survived by her husband, Neal Hoffoss, sister, Sarah Andersen, three children, Stephen Wolfson, Lisa Wolfson Copeland and Jacob Wolfson, and six grandchildren.

### 2010-11 Funding Highlights

In 2010-11, 262 grants for a total of \$2,701,301 were paid by the Hugh J. Andersen Foundation. Highlighted grant awards from the 2010-11 year include:

- \$10,000 for general operating support was granted to the Charities Review Council. The Foundation has awarded \$111,000 to the Charities Review Council since 1988.
- \$9,500 for general operating support was granted to St. Croix Festival Theatre. The Foundation has awarded \$123,500 to St. Croix Festival Theatre in St. Croix Falls, WI since 1996.
- \$7,000 was granted for Art and Literature Enrichment Programs to the Partnership Plan for Stillwater Area Schools.
- \$14,000 for general operating support and for the emergency fund was granted to the Friends In Need Food Shelf in Cottage Grove, MN.
- \$25,000 was awarded as a matching grant to the St. Croix Valley Foundation for the Our Neighbors' Place capital campaign. Our Neighbor's Place is in the process of creating a new transitional housing program for formerly homeless individuals and families in River Falls, WI.

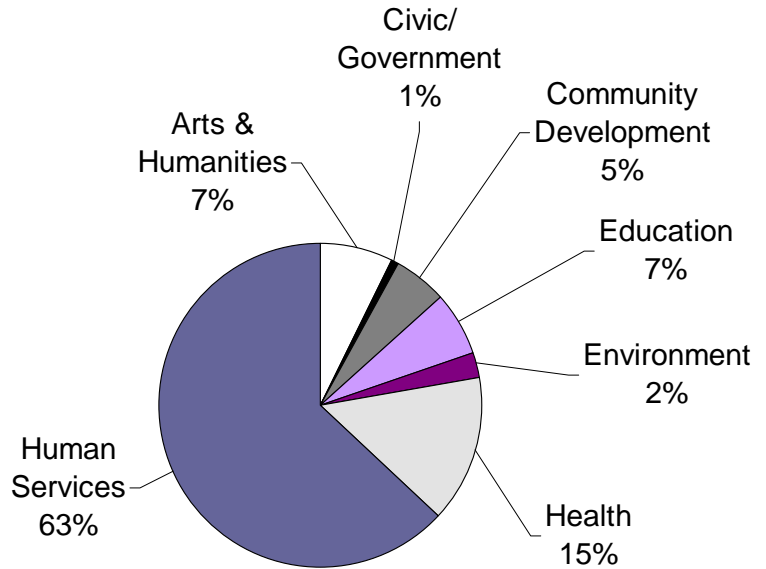
