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



LaGrange County Community Foundation continues in our mission—inspiring and sustaining generosity, leadership and service in our community.

2007 innovations which provide new opportunities for involvement in this meaningful task include:

- Establishing a Legacy Fund for donors who have decided to include the foundation in personal estate planning;
- Instituting Memorial Scholarship funds for each of the three public high schools, Lakeland, Prairie Heights and Westview;
