community foundation is a vehicle for people of all means to make a lasting difference in their community. The central purpose of a community foundation is to serve the needs and philanthropic aims of donors who wish to better their community, now and in the future. Community foundations do this by providing donors with flexible, efficient and tax-effective ways to ensure their charitable giving achieves the greatest possible impact.

The concept of a community foundation is as ingenious as it is simple; it is a means to build over time, substantial endowment funds for a community through contributions large and small. Because these contributions

are endowed, they are never spent. Instead, they are permanently invested to create income. The income earned is then used to help meet the community's charitable needs - from social work to arts and culture. So gifts to the Northern Indiana Community Foundation continue to benefit the community forever.

The Community Foundation is a public, charitable organization. This allows donors to receive the maximum tax deduction allowed. In most cases, donors claim larger tax deductions and avoid certain requirements and restrictions placed on private foundations.

You can:

- -Set up individual funds in your own name, or the name of a loved one, and have as much or as little involvement as you wish.
- -Choose to contribute to a variety of existing funds. Community foundations have a general endowment fund designed to benefit projects that are determined to have the greatest need.

UNRESTRICTED FUNDS

Unrestricted funds allow for the greatest flexibility when donating charitable gifts. These types of funds give local communities the opportunity to assess their greatest needs and assist the community's individual programs.

AGENCY FUNDS

Agency funds are for any nonprofit organization or agency that wishes to establish endowment funds with the foundation for management and investment purposes. The Community Foundation regularly distributes the annual income back to the organizations and agencies for operating their programs.

FIELD OF INTEREST FUNDS

Field of interest funds allow donors to respond to certain program areas, such as youth, education, health, environment, arts, culture, etc. Grants created from these funds specify the field of interest but not the charitable agency.

DONOR ADVISED FUNDS

Donor advised funds give the donor the advantage of assisting in charity selection each year and allows the donor exemption from federal restrictions placed on private foundations. However, the Community Foundation's board of directors makes the final decision for the grants in accordance with federal tax code regulations.

DESIGNATED FUNDS

Designated funds not only give donors the opportunity to support their favorite charity but also provide the means necessary for perpetuity. The donor simply selects the charity to support when the fund is created.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Scholarship funds may be established in memory of a loved one or to honor a friend, family member, or local hero to give deserving students the education they might not otherwise receive.

NON-PERMANENT FUNDS

Non-permanent funds are typically established at the request of a donor or agency to provide support for charitable projects and recipients as recommended by the donor. The recommendations must be advisory only, and the Community Foundation may reject a recommendation.

community services of starke county

 $m{\mathcal{U}}$ uring the early 1970s, Starke County did not have an organization to head services for the elderly or needy. That is when a woman named Sister Charles, a geriatric technician from Catholic Charities, came to meet with leaders of the community to discuss what services the county needed. Together they determined they would start small with a limited budget.







They started a Friendly Visiting program, in which Sister Charles visited seniors, took their blood pressure, and checked their overall health. Soon after came the Call-A-Day program, a daily telephone call to check on those who lived alone, and the Meals-On-Wheels program, bringing food to the homes of those who were homebound. These programs for seniors were the first manifestations of what is today known as Community Services of Starke County, which was headed by Sister Charles and Joan Haugh, who is now the executive director.

In 1977, the organization became incorporated and started receiving money from the federal government. With the new funding they were able to open congregate meal sites, at which elderly men and women could enjoy a hot meal five days a week. They also bought a van and hired a part-time driver to serve those with transportation needs.

"Catholic Charities was reluctant at first to accept federal dollars, but they realized that we could not operate successfully without assistance from the federal government," Joan said.

Soon after the organization started receiving federal dollars they began expanding and started helping those under the age of 60. In 1983 they bought another van, and in 1987 set aside \$500 to start a food pantry. At first, the food pantry served only 8-10 families a month, but that number has grown to 250 families in 2011, thanks to donations from the community and government commodities.

They began other projects, including

the Energy Assistance Program, which served upwards of 1,000 families in the community in 2011; Homemaker Services, where a case manager visits the homes of seniors to determine what assistance they need and helps bring those services to them; and Starke County Triad for promoting senior safety. Along with these programs, Community Services has a long history of responding to unforeseen needs in the county. These include a resource manual of the agencies that serve Starke County, tax preparation assistance, health equipment loans, and partnering with NIPSCO to bring the Care Hardship Program and Deposit Program to Starke County.

With new services comes more growth. With help from a Community Focus Fund (CFF) Grant in 1993, Community Services was able to move into a new building and added onto that building thanks to their second CFF Grant in 2003.

The organization has also received many grants from the Starke County Community Foundation in recent years. In 2002, the Community Foundation helped to fund the renovation of the building. The Community Foundation has also contributed money for public transit vans and gasoline, the food pantry, and for utility assistance. In 2010, Community Services created a fund with the Community Foundation to help the agency's long-term sustainability. "We are very impressed with the Community Foundation's professionalism and knowledge," said

In spite of all of the positives the

organization has brought to the county since its beginning, situations have surfaced that threaten the future of the non-profit. State funding for different programs has been cut since 2006, and Joan doesn't see the cuts stopping soon. The funding for the transportation services that Community Services provides to seniors has seen huge cuts, and more needs to be done to keep the service going. Community Services must match all of the funding they get for the programs to keep them alive, plus they have to purchase things like copiers and computers to try and keep up with the times, which creates an ongoing need for donations.

"Anyone that could remember us in their will, whether it is a dollar value or property value, or donate directly to Community Services would be helpful," Joan stated. Donations toward the Community Services of Starke County can also be made at the Starke County Community Foundation.

In the beginning the organization only had two members, Sister Charles and Joan. They have now grown to a staff of 18, which includes 8 full-time and 10 part-time workers, plus an additional 50 volunteers.

"Our salaries have never been high, but we have a good staff that cares about the community, the people, and they are willing to give," explained Joan. "When they go home at the end of the day they feel good about what they did because they've helped someone."

In 2011, Community Services of Starke County touched the lives of 5,801, or 25%, of the county's residents.

Brian Johnson Director of Development Walking into the building, one is greeted with the excited yelps and cries from the center's dogs and cats, all eager to make friends and find their new families. Outside, a young girl from the Manitou Training Center smiles as an energetic puppy on a leash pulls her around the yard. And all of these happy faces would not be possible were it not for community volunteers and their love of animals.







The Fulton County Animal Adoption and Education Center opened in October 2011 with the help of a generous grant in the amount of \$27,000 from the Fulton County Community Foundation to help with the center's start-up costs.

This center is currently the only animal shelter in Fulton County. A kennel system which took in animals did exist, but eventually the owner was no longer able to take care of them. It then became urgent that the Fulton County Animal Center find a new building in order to house and care for these animals. That building was eventually provided by the Manitou Training Center.

With two weeks left before the previous kennel closed, the Fulton County Animal Center began the overwhelming task of remodeling the new center. The task seemed daunting, but with the money from the grant, along with materials donated by others, such as tile and paint, the community was able to band together and finish the new center in such a short time.

With the money from the Community Foundation, the center was able to purchase the kennels they needed, which alone cost more than \$10,000, as well as install air conditioning, heating, and a filtration system.

According to the Center's Director Opaljean Rogers, the moving process was far from easy and required working 12 to 18 hours a day to finish in time. "It's not just 'Get a new building and move in,'" she said. "There are so many zoning laws and codes to follow." With the help from the Community Foundation and the volunteers, the move was successful and the center is now able to house the more than 60 animals that are available for adoption.

The Fulton County Leadership Academy (FCLA), which first posed the idea of establishing a shelter in the county, was also an important part of the process. As part of their requirements, each class in FCLA must work on a certain project. For the class of 2007-2008, a passion for animals combined with a growing need for a shelter in Fulton County led to a perfect project—an animal shelter.

For the next few years, even after graduating from FCLA, the group, including Mary Heal, Todd Montel, and Karen Vojtasek, continued to work towards their dream. With the help of the Community Foundation and a fund started by Kim Bowyer in memory of her daughter, Samantha Yates, the dream became a reality.

"The Fulton County Leadership

Academy absolutely helped," said Opaljean, who was also part of FCLA. "It helps you understand different businesses and how things work. We learned a lot of things about Fulton County."

Two other funds at the Community Foundation also support the center. The Fulton County Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Fund, which provides money to spay and neuter animals adopted from the center, and the Olive Jane Hathaway Animal Center Supply Fund provides support for supplies, food, and other expenses.

In addition to taking in and finding homes for these animals, the center also offers other programs, such as Jog-With-A-Dog, where people from the community can go jogging or walking with a dog, and Senior-For-Senior, where senior citizens are matched with a dog or cat 5 years or older. The center also encourages those of all ages to volunteer their time to help with the animals.

The rich history of Miami County dates back as far as the 1700s, when the Miami Indians, for which the county is named, inhabited the area. It was not until 1913 that a collection of historical artifacts about the area were shown publicly in a library exhibit by Judge Hal Phelps. The exhibit was so popular it was quickly decided that Phelps' collection, plus other items added by community members, were of high enough quality to be put on display permanently. Three years later with urgency from the Indiana governor at the time, Miami County created its first historical society, and the fourth floor of the county courthouse was picked as the first home for the museum.







Early success was shown by the new museum, and the collection of rare artifacts, most of which were early pioneer relics, reached around eight to ten thousand in the first few years. Phelps and other civic leaders started doing bigger projects, including loaning items to the Smithsonian Institution in Washington D.C. and helping other historical societies get their start. In 1932 a separate museum was created in an annex of the Peru library that was operated by the Peru School Corporation. The historical society took over as director of both museums, which housed roughly the same exhibits, while keeping headquarters in the courthouse. In the 1960s, the historical society realized that the system was severely outdated and space was too limited, so the search for a new building began.

The prayers for a new museum home were answered in 1983, when the owner of the former Senger Deptartment Store donated the building on Broadway Street to become the new Miami County Museum. The new building enabled the historical society to combine the two museums into one facility. In 1987, the exhibits at the library and courthouse began to be integrated into the new building. It took ten years to complete all three floors, but when it was done the exhibits were up-to-date and the space was perfect. The main themes in the new museum included Miami Indians, pioneers, the Wabash and Erie Canal, the circus, Cole Porter, and railroads. Original objects from the courthouse, such as the twoheaded calf, jackrabbit, and blood

stained dress of a young girl, became instant hits.

Although the space was a step up from the previous facilities the museum inhabited, the constant influx of new pieces quickly became too much to handle. It was decided another expansion was needed, and luckily a community member felt the need to help. Lucile Ulery, who was a relative of Hal Phelps, donated her estate to the museum, and another donation was used to purchase a building across the street from the current home. All of the building renovations, which are on schedule to be completed in late 2012, have been paid for entirely by donations, mostly coming from Ulery. The three-story Ulery Annex space is going to be used for programs on the first floor, and new collections storage on the second and third floors. Space to develop new exhibits will be available in the Senger building after the current pieces are moved to the new building.

It is their hope that with these new additions the museum will gain popularity and draw in a crowd of younger people who have an interest in learning about the history of the county.

Volunteers are still being welcomed to help complete the project and to make it a special place for Miami County residents.

"This is a community based project. We're trying to get different people and different groups involved, because this is their museum," said Elise Kordis, Director and Curator for the museum. "All hands on deck."

Along with the renovations being

done to the new facility, the historical society is also very active in the community. They help sponsor many festivals each year, including the Cole Porter Festival in the beginning of June, the Iron Bridge Festival in late June, and Heritage Days in August.

"We are trying to move forward, in a direction where we can apply our mission," Kordis said.

This mission, which states that their focus is to discover, collect, preserve, educate, and disseminate the history; historical records and data; and traditions which establishes or illustrates such history as it relates to Miami County, is focused on the residents of Miami County and how they can service those who call it home.

"This is a community-based museum. This is a museum for Miami County people, as well as out of town guests. We want this to be a museum they want to come visit," Kordis said.

Since 1997, the Community Foundation has granted approximately \$72,000 to the Miami County Historical Society for various programs and projects, including the Explore! Traveling Kits program with the local school corporations in which teachers can check out educational kits that help teach students about the history of the county. The historical society is also the beneficiary of approximately \$156,000 from several funds set up with the Community Foundation, including the Beulah Hoffman Fund; Marks Family Fund for the Miami County Historical Society; Miami County Historical Society, Inc. Fund; Miami County Historical Society- Ulery Annex Fund; and Robert and Lucille Ulery Memorial Fund.

Who would believe that the power of a nickel could change our community's future? Yes, that lucky nickel that you found as you walked into the grocery store could help your community. Giving five percent of one's estate in the form of a community foundation endowment can make a huge impact on one's community. This allows for individuals to leave a legacy.

Transfer of wealth or TOW is a new term; however, this term has been used for years. The transfer of wealth can include ones assets such as home(s), and other real estate, bank account(s), life insurance, investments, 401(k), IRAs, etc. In the 1920s and 1930s the famous Dust Bowl hit the Midwest, which created the start of a large economic depression. It was not until WWII that the economy changed. The 50 years following WWII were some of the most prosperous economic times the United States has ever seen. During this time many individuals transferred their wealth back to their community, and this trend has continued to grow.

In Indiana, over the next ten years, the TOW is estimated to be \$104.2 billion by the Indiana Grantmakers Alliance through a study performed by the Center for Rural Entrepreneurship.

In Starke County it is estimated that the TOW will be \$234.5 million over the next ten years. If 5% (\$11.7 million) were given to Starke County endowments, then a conservative 4% payout would provide \$468,000 annually for community needs.

In Fulton County it is estimated that the TOW will be \$268.2 million over the next ten years. If 5% (\$13.4 million) were given to Fulton County endowments, then a conservative 4% payout would provide \$536,000 annually for community needs.

In Miami County it is estimated that the TOW will be \$334.8 million over the next ten years. If 5% (16.7 million) were given to Miami County endowments, then a conservative 4% payout would provide \$668,600 annually for community needs.
